It has been the experience of photographing numerous weddings that the most memorable and complete formal photographs are begun at least ninety minutes prior to the wedding ceremony. In almost every wedding where the photographs were taken after the ceremony, many of the wedding party "went missing." Therefore, it is requested to consider this suggestion of having your wedding photographs taken prior to your ceremony.
